Boris Ostrerov Artist Statement

Catharsis, suppression, the drama and violence in the act of painting, and the physical and visual properties of paint inspire me to paint.

Paint is intuitively jabbed, thrown, squeezed from tubes or cake-decorating bags, squirted, smeared and scraped. Layers of paint run into, over and under each other in a literal and metaphorical battle of drives, forces, emotions and energies confined to the rectangular support like those taking place in and between our minds and bodies.

My paintings are imbued with mystery, aggression, crudeness, and directness that explores the "darker" side of life and human nature. The paintings are not windows into an illusory world. They'll jump out and penetrate the viewers space before being passed by unnoticed. They exist. Defiantly here and now, changing as the paint ages, and demanding the viewer's presence to explore them from different perspectives that unveil stimulating discoveries. The visual and physical acrobatics, application and materiality of the paint arouses awe and curiosity, sometimes with a simultaneous dose of fright, like attraction and disgust.

Biography

Boris Ostrerov earned a BFA in Painting from the Milwaukee Institute of Art and Design and an MFA in Painting and Drawing at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago in 2013. Ostrerov has exhibited widely and has earned several opportunities including showing at AREA Gallery, Slow Gallery, Paris London Hong Kong (PLHK), and Lubov Gallery. He has been featured in publications including New American Paintings #119 and the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel. Ostrerov's painting was included in the New American Paintings show at the Elmhurst Art Museum in 2016. Ostrerov currently lives in Chicago.
