Mac Pierce Artist Statement Keys to the Castle

These works draw on my experience delving into unexplored corners of the internet, areas of informatic diffusion where the delineation between the private and public become penetrable. Utilizing materials obtained through various leaks of classified information, each artwork articulates a different model by which secrets diffuse into the sphere of public knowledge. Through the action of leaking, the apparatuses of power containing these secrets are revealed, and through that revelation the formless secret is given shape. As translated into a physical form, these objects point back towards their origin, those being clandestine systems where secrets are power.

Biography

Mac Pierce (He/Him) (b. 1993, Seattle, WA) is a Chicago based artist and creative technologist that critically engages with weaponized emerging technologies. Raised in Idaho, he studied fine arts at the University of Idaho and self-taught various digital technologies to incorporate into his artistic practice. Refining his practice, he received his MFA in studio arts from the Art and Technology Studies department at the School of the Art institute of Chicago. He has participated in expositions including Expo Chicago and Ars Electronica and is in collections both domestic and international.

Vein of an Angel

Sourced from a trove of documents stolen from the Indian Air Force, *Vein of an Angel* contains a made-to-specifi-cation copy of a hydraulic joint from an angel of death, the Russian Sukhoi S-U30 fighter jet.

The philatory itself is composed of the same materials used in the combat aircraft- composite plastics, aluminum, mil-spec hardware, etc. providing an analogous body for the joint to inhabit. The joint, an integral component in the operation of the aircraft, is but one part of the whole of something entirely unattainable. Through revelations (leaks) this auraed entity becomes defined, allowing an initial understanding of the workings of this angel of death.

Of note - The fabrication specifications for this object were only accessible within the tens of thousands of docu-ments divulged because it was under review by the quality control division of the Indian Air Force, having burst under the pressure of the hydraulic from




Fig. A – fabrication diagram of the hydraulic joint

Sciamachy (Shadow Boxing)

Though transparency is the rhetorical opposite of opacity, the two exist in parallel when understanding the ways secrets are hidden in plain sight. Mundane details, when properly understood and acted upon, can have enormous consequences. Within the apparatuses built to limit the spread of secrets, control of information can take many forms, such as physical security, redactions, or security through obscurity. But sometimes that information bypasses all control and is released unredacted. This can happen unintentionally or as a stratagem, taking the form of a true leak. In this scenario, information that holds power is released without any control on what is obscured, and when that happens, that power tends to contaminate its surroundings.

Take for instance the documents found stored at Mar-a-Lago in 2021-22, where thousands of government documents of various levels of classification were found placed haphazardly around the grounds of the club and stored in legal boxes, innocuous containers that masked the true power of their contents. Following the investigation, photos of these boxes were circulated, while any loose documents were shown fully redacted. Much speculation occurred on the contents of the boxes, but ultimately the specifics of the information contained remains unknown. The shadow of redactions cast a full blanket over what was in the boxes and as a result the boxes became signifiers of unknown power.

Contained within Sciamachy are the maximum number of pages that could fit within a standard legal box, numbering 3,600 pages divided into 100-page stapled packets. Each is fully printed and redacted, allowing the viewer to only guess at the weight of the information that could be potentially contained.



C/S/TS

This print is derived from the leak of classified documents by 21 year old Massachusetts Air National Guard member Jack Tiexeira, who over the course of 2022 and 2023 leaked an estimated 64 documents onto the gaming chat service Discord. Tiexeira is believed to have done so to win disputes on the server, settling arguments with other adolescent users by leveraging his access to top secret information.

Accessed by the artist, these documents related to the specifics of equipment being sent to Ukraine, as well as the disposition of the United States fleet in regard to the defense of Taiwan, amongst other topics. Contained were 225 markings denoting the documents as classified, ranging from Confidential, Secret, to Top Secret. These were the glyphs that when seen, elevated the information within to that of near sacred importance. This aura of secrecy and the glyphs that bestow it manifested as a curse upon the documents, as when shared publicly Tiexeira found out that they had the ability to manifest FBI helicopters and SWAT teams.

Reproduced as they appeared in the leaked photos, C/S/TS displays all 225 classified markings.
